

→ ECONOMIC ATTRACTIONS OF THE UCKERMARK DISTRICT

North-east Brandenburg, nestled between the capital city of Berlin and the Szczecin metropolitan area in Poland, is home to one of the largest and most beautiful districts in the whole of Germany. Even in the Middle Ages, the commercial roads gave the settlement structure of the region national significance.

The geographically favourable location of Uckermark's towns and municipalities offers the best possible transport links to numerous economic areas across Europe. The A11 [E28 Berlin - Szczecin] and A20 (E22 interchange Uckermark - Lübeck) federal motorways cross the region, creating links to trans-European traffic routes between Northern and Southern Europe (Scandria Corridor, Scandinavian-Adriatic Development Area) and serving as the axis between Western and Eastern Europe.

Both the European inland waterway network and the Baltic Sea port in Szczecin and Swinoujscie (Poland) can be reached from the modern port in Schwedt/Oder. Furthermore, the Uckermark district offers unparalleled natural areas and numerous culture and leisure activities. A space where you can live, work, and be happy.

→ SCHWEDT/ODER

Schwedt Industrial Estate (German Acronym: IPS)

This industrial area is located right by the Polish border, on the north-western outskirts of Schwedt/Oder. Here are found not just the most powerful refineries in Europe, but also an additional 90 companies that make this area a Brandenburg heavyweight. The professionals at the location can take care of the planning, construction and maintenance and inspection of your industrial relocation. A particular feature of this location is its immediate proximity to raw materials and industrial and agricultural materials. Refinery products such as raw materials, synergies created from by-products made by local companies, vapour at different steam pressure levels, electric power, gas and auxiliary materials such as compressed air, nitrogen, cooling water, drinking water and sewage disposal. All at one location!

The industrial Port Area of the same name lies directly on the trimodal Schwedt/Oder inland port. Your raw materials and goods can arrive from all over the world by coastal vessel, by truck or by rail. Modern techniques and capable port operators ensure that your goods and materials will be handled smoothly. The potential for synergies is offered by a powerful bio-gas plant, which produces approx. 60 million kWha of biomethane, but also by local companies and the excellent access to the regional and trans-European transport routes.

→ PRENZLAU

The northern and eastern industrial areas are in the urban area of **Prenzlau**, right by the Uckermark motorway junction that links up to the A11/E28 (Berlin-Szczecin-Minsk) and A20/E22 (interchange Uckermark-Lübeck-Hamburg) motorways.

Thanks to those nearby motorways, the Berlin and Szczecin metropolitan areas and cities in the North Sea and Baltic Sea regions can be reached quickly and safely.

This location is being dramatically developed by the metal processing/metalworking industry and the energy and food industries. Manufacturers of fittings for refrigeration systems, water and gas utilities are also here, as are an ice cream manufacturer and a dairy.

The small but powerful **Blindow business park** is just north of Prenzlau. The convenient location, directly by the No. 109 main road, means you can reach the Nos. 11 and 20 motorways in less than 15 minutes. Companies operating in the services, construction and window construction sectors have already established themselves here.
